A copy of the letter we are sending to the WSBA-ODC is attached. The decision as to what, if any, action should be taken vis-à-vis Mr. Pelley's license is a matter for the Office of Disciplinary Counsel. For a number of reasons, including the basis for the Decline decision and the fact that no one at the KCPAO has any direct personal knowledge of any of the events at issue, we do not believe it is appropriate for us to offer an opinion or take a position beyond that which is contained in the letter and the attachments.
